

AWANA Rules

1. Awana clubbers should arrive for club no earlier than **5:45 p.m.** and should be picked up by **7:30 p.m.**
2. Upon dismissal, parents should come into the church to pick up clubbers. You will need to find your child with their Handbook leader and sign them out. Cubbie parents will sign them out in the Cubbies' room. We want to make sure that no child is overlooked and that they only leave with the appropriate adults.
3. Clubbers should always stay with their club and only go into the classrooms that their club is using.
4. Clubbers do not go onto the stage in the sanctuary (unless they are told to do so).
5. No running in the church (except during game time, in the fellowship hall).
6. Clubbers and leaders are to wear their uniforms to club meetings so they can be easily identified.
7. Listen and follow directions.
8. Raise your hand for permission to speak.
9. Always be polite and use good manners.
10. Treat others the way you want to be treated.
11. If your child has a cell phone with them at club, they are not to use it unless they need to contact a parent/guardian. If they need to contact a parent/guardian, they need to let their leader know that is what they are doing **before** using their phone. Otherwise, we recommend that cell phones stay at home.
12. If your child misbehaves the following three steps will be taken:
 - First incident-Clubber will receive a warning and told what they did wrong
 - Second incident-Clubber will be taken aside and given a second warning and told what they did wrong.
 - Third incident-Clubber will be removed from the rest of their group for the rest of the night (Cubbies will only be away from their group for the remainder of the activity), they will be told what they did wrong, and parents will be informed of the incident.
